The following activities are suggested to help students learn more about Saint John Bosco, his ministry and his contributions to today's society.

2. Write and act out a brief skit based on Saint John Bosco's life.

4. Saint John Bosco taught youth about religion, and even wrote and published materials to help with this. If Saint John Bosco were teaching your religion class today, what would be the most important thing he could teach your class about religion? Why would this be so important?
5. Saint John Bosco helped young people. What is one thing you could do during this next week to help someone younger than you, perhaps a younger sibling or a younger student at your school?
